

## **SCHOOL RULES**

Pupils are not allowed to leave the school grounds at any time without permission.

Pupils who drive to school are not permitted to park on school premises.

Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is strictly forbidden in school, on the school grounds and on all school outings.

Students are forbidden to have drugs, (including cigarettes and e-cigarettes), in their possession for use or for sale.

Pupils must attend school regularly and be punctual. Pupils must submit a written explanation for each absence to the school secretary or Year Head on the day of return.

Within class, pupils are expected to behave in a proper manner in accordance with the Code of Conduct.

## Students are expected to:

- Allow the teacher to teach and fellow students to be taught
- Do all of the work assigned to them to the highest standard possible
- Be fully prepared for class
- To move without delay from class to class, in good order and in the appropriate direction.

School uniform, as specified, must be worn correctly. Only school crested jackets are allowed to be worn in classes and on the premises during the school day. Strictly no wearing of 'hoodies' allowed. Students are not permitted to wear make-up at Junior level.

Pupils are required to respect school property. Any damage to school property must be made good and refurbishing/repair costs, paid on demand.

Chewing gum is forbidden within the school.

The use of mobile phones is not allowed in the school at any time except with the express permission of a teacher for use under supervision in the classroom.

The use of any other electronic devices, (e.g. MP3 players, or I Pods, etc) are not allowed on the school premises, unless permission has been granted by a teacher.
