Here in St. Joseph's, through the SPHE, (Social, Personal and Health Education), Wellbeing programme, and other classes, students learn to develop important skills for living a healthy and well-balanced life. Elements of SPHE and Wellbeing are also approached in such subjects as Religious Education, Science, Biology and Home Economics.

The RSE, (Relationships and Sexuality Education), programme which is a component of SPHE is about providing information in a structure which promotes the development of responsible attitudes, values and beliefs about sexuality, relationships and intimacy.
